I am grateful to the Lord for the opportunity to spend this time with you as brothers and sisters, February 18-20, 2011. Let's trust Him together for the unhindered work of His Spirit in each one of us. I will be praying with you to that end!

In my own journey of faith, I thought I was reasonably sharp and able to connect with the truths and insights of Scripture. But over time, I began to conclude that there were many things that I was slow catching on to--which

in turn, made for painful challenges in relationships and all of life. The prophet Isaiah, speaking about how the nations will come to the House of the God of Jacob for a specific purpose, said that it would be so that God could "show us the way he works."

But then he goes on to say that there is a secondary focus. We need to understand how God works so that we can live the way He created us to live, the way He planned for us to live, "the way we're made." By implication, He is saying that if we do NOT understand the ways that he works, we will NOT be able to live out the design He planned. Make sense?

One of the most exciting aspects of my journey is working hard at learning to understand the ways He works, so that I can live the way He made me to live. In these sessions, we will be exploring the ways God works in relationships, the ways He shapes and defines us

from conception onward, and the ways that definition of who we become affects every relationship we have. Sometimes in the busy-ness of life we never stop to ask ourselves why we do the things we do!?! This is an important question for each of us to ask, from early teens to seniors, male or female, single or married, or single again. As people, we face the same kinds of issues and challenges, so I would encourage each of us to begin reflecting on some of the reasons why we do what we do when it comes to relationships.

For example, do I get defensive, do I retreat, do I withdraw, or do I go silent? Do I get angry, fearful, anxious, determined, or lonely? Do I feel rejected, abandoned, discouraged, left out, put down, excited, encouraged, or on top of the world? Let's anticipate exploring together "how He works."

We will look at three planes of relationship--with the Father, with those around us, and with ourselves. We will also explore the many ways the enemy comes "to steal, to kill, and to destroy." If we are to live the way the Father planned, we must understand how He intends for us to stand against the lies and the wiles of the enemy.

Jesus said He came to give life, and life abundant. The real keys to living full and free are in our coming to Jesus and allowing Him to do what He said He came to do! Let's anticipate finding a fresh awareness of His power and presence in our lives during our time together in February.

We are delighted to now have an established HOPE Ministries Board. We went where Jesus led. Jesus showed me pictures of what my heart was like and what He can do to heal it.... There are still things J won't know until J'm in a situation but if Jesus is holding my hand, it's okay. J don't need to fear the unknown.

Amazing Grace; Amazing Healing

Seventeen years in El Salvador. Seventeen blessed years of active, intense care to rural Salvadorans who both came to our mission sponsored clinic and

were involved in our local church. Gradually the thrill and joy that had been mine as I served others were replaced with heavy weights of fulfilling "shoulds" and pleasing people. Whenever I dropped the juggling

acts of my many self-imposed activities, I would feel guilty. Nights became long as sleep escaped me; severe headaches, my too frequent companion, turned into nausea; my relationship with God, as with people, seemed wanting; though disillusionment reigned, I plowed ahead sure that I was irreplaceable; burnout was coming to haunt me.

That was the scenario I brought to Nevin and Joann last March early on in my sabbatical. They graciously received me, listened to my heart, encouraged me and pointed me to Jesus. The Lord God spoke my heart lan-

guage: showing Himself to clearly be my Initiator. What had been only intellectual knowledge now translated deeply into soul understanding. The lie that my rela-

tionship with God was dependent on me was swallowed up in the truths: It is not up to me to either initiate or maintain our relationship. I am under His care. He is responsible for

me. I don't have to hang on to Him. He's holding me up.

In the months that followed the Lord God became my daily Beloved Counselor as I wrote in my journal. He spoke life-freeing Truths as I faithfully recorded them in my notebook. Repeat-

edly He revealed that I should not be disillusioned when my soul needs of connection, affirmation, respect and honor are not met by people. When someone ignores me

or does not give me respect, I should choose neither to stuff my needs by denying their validity

nor should I choose to resent Instead I am invited people. to look to the Source of all comfort, true connection, affirmation and honor--Jesus Christ. Bountiful Provider who made me with these needs waits to richly pour in what people are unable to supply. In fact, He sets up circumstances so that we become aware of our need. What joy it brings Him when we look to Him for His filling! What joy we receive in knowing our Generous, Loving Father is daily looking out for our emotional needs! We are not forgotten, not overlooked, and not ignored. We are His treasured possession.

Today almost a year later my headaches are gone; my energy is back; my heart is full. I am ready to return to serve in El Sal-

vador in three and a half weeks. Amazing grace; amazing healing; amazing love from our amazing

Creator!
