## Change! BY NEVIN & JOANN NISLY

*"So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into His glorious image." II Corinthians 3:18 NLT*

As we traveled through the hills of Vermont and New Hampshire celebrating our 10th anniversary, we took notice of the yellows, oranges, and reds of the leaves as they did what they do every year. Change! (Change happens as we leave the old and adapt to the new.) The changing of leaves means leaving summer and moving into winter.

For children as they leave one grade, they have the transition of summer break and then move to a new grade. Sometimes we leave one location and go to a new one. We don't need to look far around us to see changes happening. Children growing up, families growing, produce growing, etc. These changes are all part of the process of growth and bring about more maturity in our lives. We don't make the internal change, but God uses our environment, thoughts, and actions to develop the change that happens within.

Sometimes we like the changes and sometimes we don't. Sometimes a very traumatic circumstance forces change. We often need to grieve loss in the changes that these traumas bring. Because of God's great love, He is able to take these awful things and redeem them unexplainably. Sometimes it is difficult to trust Him to do this. Because of His love, He understands our grief.



Sometimes we long for change in our personal lives. It can get frustrating when we can't make changes like we want to. It's frustrating seeing ourselves needy or hurting. To recognize that all we need to do is be faithful in the small things God allows into our lives can be freeing. He does the change for us.

A number of years ago Nevin saw purpose in an old roll top desk that someone wanted to be rid of. Joann didn't want the "junk" around the place. It looked like an impossible task, but Nevin saw a desk that could be fixed and purposeful and nice. We brought it home and with some sanding, a little refinishing, and some work on fixing a drawer, change took place. Today we have a very useable and nice desk because of some effort that was broken down into smaller jobs. When God sees us, He sees purpose and is willing to walk with us in each of the steps that change requires.

Eleven years ago, we left the occupation of teaching and changed our course to walking with adults on a regular basis as they desired more personal enrichment. We began meeting with people in the basement of our temporary residence. Through this we saw changes we would make when we had our own place.
